"The 2023 Rosé Spätburgunder, as it is referred to on the consumer label, is a dry tank-fermented wine made from fruit picked on vines planted in the early 1990s as well as recently planted ones in the backside of the main hill of the Dhroner Hofberger. This light-salmon clear Rosé delivers a nicely perfumed and refined nose of rose petal, orange blossom, minty herbs, raspberry, and smoke. The wine is delicately juicy and refreshing on the light yet nicely complex palate, which offers plenty of spices, smoke, and zest. The finish is very clean and pure, with good length. This combines finesse with some structure and nice complexity.
